**Recreational League Members will play 1 hr games using traditional scoring 15, 15, 15 Play all 3 games.**

**All Other League Members: Quads, Doubles, Coed 4's, intermediate Coed 6's will use Rally Scoring to 21, 1 hour Games scoring is as follows:**

**25, 25, 15 games are capped at 27 for the first 2 games and 17 for the last game.**

**1.5 MINUTES ARE ALLOWED BETWEEN EACH GAME THIS IS A TIME TO TAKE A DRINK OR GET REFRESHED NOT TO STAND AROUND AND TALK.**

**Play a 3 Games, it will all be recorded for overall record. Score sheets must be turned in the night of your game to to accounted for.**

**\*\*\*\*If the serve contacts the net and goes over the net the serve is legal\*\*\*\***

- **6-person teams must have @ least 3 people present to play without forfeiting.**
- **4-person teams must have @ least 2 people present to play without forfeiting.**
- **Co-Ed 6's At anytime there may be no more guys than girls, Example: 2 girls 4 guys will not work, the maximum amount of guys playing at a time is 3. However you may have more girls than guys playing up to 6 women. 4's 2 women and 2 guys or 3-1 women or all 4 women.**
- **Co-Ed 6's a girl must hit the ball at least once before ball is returned to other team.**
- **Co-Ed 4's a girl must hit the ball at least once before ball is returned to other team.**
- **1st team listed will serve 1st and 3rd games. You must win by two. If time is called the team ahead wins**
- **Each team will play 3 games - no matter who wins the first two. Standings will be based on the number of games won by each team. The top teams with the most wins from the 1st and 2nd halves will be invited back for playoffs on week 17. Winning team each night of league play is responsible for reporting the game results, if they are not received that evening they will not be accounted for.**
- **VOLLEY'S WILL NEVER CANCEL A LEAGUE. WE WILL PLAY RAIN OR SHINE UNLESS EXTREME WEATHER CONDITIONS. Example (lightning storm) \*\*Lighting in the distance does NOT constitute a cancelation of league. We will have Doppler radar to tell us if the storm will pass within the hour or not. If the two teams agree to postpone, it is their responsibility to schedule a makeup before the last week of that session. Any games not made up will NOT be counted as wins for either team. If we cancel we will post a make up date, if that does not work for your team you & the other team captain will be responsible for make ups. Open Court time will be posted for your teams to use for makeups or practice.**

**A team can rotate players into the game at any position. When rotating positions, everyone must rotate, not just in the front row or back row.**

- **Stay out of the net! If you are in the net, call yourself. This is very important if you to have an injury free game.**
- **In the sand there is no center line. However, you cannot interfere with a player on the other side. If a player feels they were interfered with, they were. REPLAY THE POINT**
- **The line is in. We will have boundary markers(If the line moves... the ball is in.**

**You cannot block a set or a bump on the first or second hit. You may block a set or bump if it is the third hit. A team has a right to three hits.**

- **A serve cannot be attacked. The ball must fall below the plane of the net before it can be contacted.**
- **A block does not count as a hit. You can play the ball immediately after blocking it. A woman blocking does not satisfy the Co-Ed rule. A male bumping the ball over after a partial block does not violate the Co-Ed Rule.**
- **Serving: You may serve anywhere behind the back line and between the standards. If a player does not like their toss, too bad. A server gets only one toss.**

- **Out of Bounds. A player cannot enter another court.**
- **Double hits are allowed on the serve and on a driven ball (spike). Lifts are not! If the momentum of the ball forces the hand back, there has been a lift. A player must attack the ball.**
- **Call your own side of the net. Volleyball is a game of honor. Referee your side of the net.**

#### Eligibility of Players

- **All players' names must be on the team roster (maximum of 12 players per team). Team rosters are due by the 2nd week of play.**
- **A player must participate in 2 full matches to be eligible in the play-offs and /or for prizes.**

#### Volleyballs

**Volleyballs will carry Spalding "King Of The Beach" Volleyballs for use or you may use your own if both teams agree . A ball can be checked out with various forms of ID. You are responsible for the ball you borrow. Return the ball and pick up your ID. Be sure you have the right ball and ID. Replacing a ball costs \$34.95 or you may purchase your own "King Of The Beach" for \$34.95.**

#### Practice Times

**Volleyballs members may practice on open courts Monday through Sunday beginning at 11:00AM - 5:45PM. Open play will continue after league until 1:00AM if needed. Any other customer other than volley's members must pay \$5.00 per person per hour to play and fill out a release form. All players before open play must sign in with bartender on duty on patio or Trophy's to allow us to provide the best service possible.**

**Open Court Edict. After league play, or during Sunday practice times, teams can practice on an open court. If the courts are all in use, a team cannot refuse a challenge. Another team can challenge the winner. Doubles are limited to three courts.**

#### Complex Rules

- **All players must be members. If you need to add a teammate to your roster you must fill out an "ADD A MEMBER FORM" In a playoffs situation, all members will be checked prior to start to make sure players are not stacking their team to win the playoffs. If they are not on the roster or were not added they will not be able to play. No Exceptions. Any team using players not on "roster" by the 2nd week or have not been added during the season will forfeit any wins they have had during the tournament.**
- **Play is at your own risk. We have no insurance.**
- **Pets, packaged beverages and coolers are not allowed to be brought in. State Law.**
- **Children must be under direct adult supervision at all times. If both parents are playing the child is not under direct supervision. For everyone's safety, children are not allowed on the courts or between the courts.**
- **We have a zero tolerance policy for physical, verbal or destructive behavior**
- **Violation of club rules or policies can result in suspension and forfeiture of fees.**

**Customers who bring their children with them are expected to control their behavior and be responsible for their actions. We please ask that you keep your children where you can see them at all times. Please do not allow them to run around or between the courts, build sand castles or dig holes with water or push feet wash or showers which floods certain areas of the courts. This is to help insure no harm to them and our volleyball customers at volley's while they enjoy the sport of sand volleyball. Thank You.**
